2. Purpose Of PAIA Manual

To promote effective governance of private bodies, it is necessary to ensure that everyone is empowered and educated to understand their rights in terms of PAIA, in order for them to exercise their rights in relation to public and private bodies.

Wherever reference is made to "Private Body" in this manual, it will refer to Goal Reach Trading 21 CC t/a TK's Transport.

This PAIA Manual is useful for the public to -

- 2.1 check the categories of records held by a body which are available without a person having to submit a formal PAIA request;
- 2.2 have a sufficient understanding of how to make a request for access to a record of the body, by providing a description of the subjects on which the body holds records and the categories of records held on each subject;
- 2.3 know the description of the records of the body which are available in accordance with any other legislation;
- 2.4 access all the relevant contact details of the Information Officer and Deputy Information Officer who will assist the public with the records they intend to access;
- 2.5 know the description of the guide on how to use PAIA, as updated by the Regulator and how to obtain access to it;
- 2.6 know if the body will process personal information, the purpose of processing of personal information and the description of the categories of data subjects and of the information or categories of information relating thereto;
- 2.7 know the description of the categories of data subjects and of the information or categories of information relating thereto;
- 2.8 know the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal information may be supplied;
- 2.9 know if the body has planned to transfer or process personal information outside the Republic of South Africa and the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal information may be supplied; and

2.10 know whether the body has appropriate security measures to ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the personal information which is to be processed.

4. Guide On How To Use PAIA And How To Obtain Access To The Guide

- 4.1 The Regulator has, in terms of section 10(1) of PAIA, as amended, updated, and made available the revised Guide on how to use PAIA ("Guide"), in an easily comprehensible form and manner, as may reasonably be required by a person who wishes to exercise any right contemplated in PAIA and POPIA.
- 4.2 The Guide is available in each of the official languages and in braille.
- 4.3 The aforesaid Guide contains the description of-
 - 4.3.1. the objects of PAIA and POPIA;
 - 4.3.2. the postal and street address, phone and fax number and, if available, electronic mail address of
 - 4.3.2.1. the Information Officer of every public body, and
 - 4.3.2.2. every Deputy Information Officer of every public and private body designated in terms of section 17(1) of PAIA¹ and section 56 of POPIA²;
 - 4.3.3. the manner and form of a request for-
 - 4.3.3.1. access to a record of a public body contemplated in section 113; and
 - 4.3.3.2. access to a record of a private body contemplated in section 50⁴;

¹ Section 17(1) of PAIA- For the purposes of PAIA, each public body must, subject to legislation governing the employment of personnel of the public body concerned, designate such number of persons as deputy information officers as are necessary to render the public body as accessible as reasonably possible for requesters of its records.

² Section 56(a) of POPIA- Each public and private body must make provision, in the manner prescribed in section 17 of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, with the necessary changes, for the designation of such a number of persons, if any, as deputy information officers as is necessary to perform the duties and responsibilities as set out in section 55(1) of POPIA.

³ Section 11(1) of PAIA- A requester must be given access to a record of a public body if that requester complies with all the procedural requirements in PAIA relating to a request for access to that record; and access to that record is not refused in terms of any ground for refusal contemplated in Chapter 4 of this Part.

⁴ Section 50(1) of PAIA- A requester must be given access to any record of a private body if-

a) that record is required for the exercise or protection of any rights;

b) that person complies with the procedural requirements in PAIA relating to a request for access to that record; and

c) access to that record is not refused in terms of any ground for refusal contemplated in Chapter 4 of this Part.

- 4.3.4. the assistance available from the Information Officer of a public body in terms of PAIA and POPIA;
- 4.3.5. the assistance available from the Regulator in terms of PAIA and POPIA;
- 4.3.6. all remedies in law available regarding an act or failure to act in respect of a right or duty conferred or imposed by PAIA and POPIA, including the manner of lodging-
 - 4.3.6.1. an internal appeal;
 - 4.3.6.2. a complaint to the Regulator; and
 - 4.3.6.3. an application with a court against a decision by the information officer of a public body, a decision on internal appeal or a decision by the Regulator or a decision of the head of a private body;
- 4.3.7. the provisions of sections 14⁵ and 51⁶ requiring a public body and private body, respectively, to compile a manual, and how to obtain access to a manual;
- 4.3.8.the provisions of sections 15⁷ and 52⁸ providing for the voluntary disclosure of categories of records by a public body and private body, respectively;
- 4.3.9.the notices issued in terms of sections 22° and 54¹0 regarding fees to be paid in relation to requests for access; and

⁵ Section 14(1) of PAIA- The information officer of a public body must, in at least three official languages, make available a manual containing information listed in paragraph 4 above.

⁶ Section 51(1) of PAIA- The head of a private body must make available a manual containing the description of the information listed in paragraph 4 above.

⁷ Section 15(1) of PAIA- The information officer of a public body, must make available in the prescribed manner a description of the categories of records of the public body that are automatically available without a person having to request access

⁸ Section 52(1) of PAIA- The head of a private body may, on a voluntary basis, make available in the prescribed manner a description of the categories of records of the private body that are automatically available without a person having to request access

⁹ Section 22(1) of PAIA- The information officer of a public body to whom a request for access is made, must by notice require the requester to pay the prescribed request fee (if any), before further processing the request.

¹⁰ Section 54(1) of PAIA- The head of a private body to whom a request for access is made must by notice require the requester to pay the prescribed request fee (if any), before further processing the request.

5. Categories Of Records Of The Private Body Which Are Available Without A Person Having To Request Access

The following records are available to the public without having to submit a formal request for access in terms of PAIA:

- Private body profile and general information about services offered (transport, storage, and warehousing).
- Product brochure;
- Standard terms and conditions of carriage and warehousing.
- Company website information.
- Publicly available compliance certificates or accreditations (where published).

6. Description Of the Records of The Private Body Which Are Available In Accordance With Any Other Legislation

The private body is required to maintain certain records in accordance with, but not limited to, the following legislation:

(d) uniform criteria to be applied by the information officer of a public body when deciding which categories of records are to be made available in terms of section 15; and

¹¹ Section 92(1) of PAIA provides that -"The Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, make regulations regarding-

⁽a) any matter which is required or permitted by this Act to be prescribed;

⁽b) any matter relating to the fees contemplated in sections 22 and 54;

- Companies Act 71 of 2008 company registration records, shareholder information, director information.
- Labour Relations Act 66 of 1995 employment contracts, disciplinary records, labour relations documentation.
- Basic Conditions of Employment Act 75 of 1997 employee attendance registers, leave records, working hours.
- Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 employment equity plans and reports.
- Skills Development Act 97 of 1998 training records, skills development plans.
- Unemployment Insurance Act 63 of 2001 employee contribution records.
- Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act 130 of 1993 workplace injury reports.
- National Road Traffic Act 93 of 1996 fleet licensing records, driver permits, vehicle compliance records.
- Tax Administration Act 28 of 2011 and Income Tax Act 58 of 1962 financial and tax records.
- Value-Added Tax Act 89 of 1991 VAT records.
- POPIA (Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013) records related to data subject information and processing activities

7. Description Of The Subjects On Which The Body Holds Records And Categories Of Records Held On Each Subject By the Private Body

- Private Body Administration incorporation documents, governance records, CIPC document.
- Financial Records annual financial statements, tax records, invoices, receipts, audit reports.
- Human Resources employment contracts, personal files of employees, training records, payroll data, leave records.
- Operations contracts with clients, service level agreements, route schedules, delivery notes, waybills, proof of delivery.
- Fleet Management vehicle registration documents, maintenance records, fuel usage logs, driver logs, GPS tracking data.
- Warehousing & Storage warehouse inventory records, goods received notes, storage agreements, stock reports.
- Health and Safety workplace safety audits, incident reports, compliance certificates.
- Clients & Customers customer contracts, orders, communications, billing information.
- Suppliers and Service Providers contracts, invoices, service agreements.
- Information Technology system usage logs, access records, software licenses.

8. Processing Of Personal Information

8.1 Purpose of processing personal information

The private body processes personal information for purposes including, but not limited to:

- Facilitating transport, logistics, storage and warehousing services.
- Managing customer accounts, contracts, billing, and communication.
- Managing employee relations, payroll, benefits, and performance.
- Ensuring compliance with labour, tax, and transport legislation.
- Maintaining vehicle and fleet safety, route planning, and driver scheduling.
- Enhancing customer service and responding to queries or complaints.
- Marketing and business development purposes.
- Security monitoring, access control and fraud prevention.

8.2 Description of the categories of Data Subjects and of the information or categories of information relating thereto.

The private body may hold records relating to the following data subjects:

- Employees and Job Applicants personal details, employment history, qualifications, medical records (where required), payroll and banking details.
- Customers/Clients contact information, company registration details, VAT numbers, contract information, delivery details, billing and payment history.
- Suppliers/Contractors business contact information, B-BBEE certificates, banking details, service agreements
- Fleet Drivers identity documents, driver's licenses, training records, disciplinary records, tracking logs.
- Visitors to Premises identification details, access records, CCTV footage.

8.3 The recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal information may be supplied.

Personal information may be shared with the following recipients, where applicable and in line with POPIA:

- Statutory bodies and regulators (e.g., SARS, Department of Labour, Department of Transport).
- External auditors, accountants and legal advisors.
- Financial institutions (for payment processing).
- Insurance companies and brokers.
- Industry regulators and compliance authorities.
- IT service providers and data storage providers (subject to confidentiality).
- Customers and suppliers where contractual obligations require disclosure.
- Law enforcement or other authorities where legally obliged.
- 8.4 Planned transborder flow of personal information. N/A
- 8.5 General description of information security measures to be implemented by the responsible party to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of the information.

The private body has implemented appropriate, reasonable technical and organisational measures to safeguard personal information, including:

- Restricted access to personal information on a "need-to-know" basis.
- Password protection and user authentication for IT systems.
- Firewalls, anti-virus software, and intrusion detection systems.
- Encrypted communication and data storage where applicable.
- Secure physical storage for paper-based records.
- CCTV monitoring and controlled access to premises.
- Regular employee training on POPIA compliance and information handling.
- Contracts with third-party service providers ensuring POPIA compliance.
- Backup and disaster recovery systems to ensure data availability.
